Since the mass actions by the opposition forces on the 16th,17th and 31st of January in the capital Khartoum, strong peaceful demonstrations spread to other cities including Atbara,Singa,Potsudan,Alobied .These mass protest actions were targeting the bankrupt economic policies of the regime, the wrenching of political freedoms, the release of all detainees and stop to the regimes military actions in Western Sudan.

The regime to stop the growing mass demonstrations has resorted to the use of excessive powers which resulted in the death of ten people and over hundred were injured. In addition over 400 persons were detained including the leaders of the opposition forces.

The regime and its allies inside and outside the country activated their search for a solution to avoid the expected down fall of the regime. Their action are aiming at breaking the unity of action of the opposition forces and imposing a solution that remove the main corrupt figures and to include new forces whose interests form of the capitalist way of development.

At present the situation i the country remains to be tense, with the opposition preparing for a month of mass actions including demonstrations, seminars and sit in .

It worth mentioning that high on the agenda of the opposition is the continuation of the campaign for the release of the political detainees ,and the building of the resistance committees in residential areas, work places and universities.

Solidarity with palestine

On the occasion of the 42nd anniversary of Alard Day, the Palestinian have marked the with mass demonstrations in the Gaza strip and the West Bank. The Israeli occupation reacted with excessive use of force killing over 17 peaceful demonstrators and injuring over one thousands.

The Palestinian Authority has called on the UN Security Council for a speedy action to protect the Palestinian people.

The reports informed that 1000 Palestinians injured by tear gas inhalation and from being struck by live rounds or rubber-coated bullets, the first to be killed was a Palestinian farmer, said to be working his fields.

Number of protesters Israel killed in Gaza today rises to 9, with more 1200 casualties, The protests were organized as “The Great March of Return,” “Alard Day” a nonviolent gathering of Palestinian refugees who demand the right to return to their families’ homes inside Israel. Nearly 2 million Gazans are virtually imprisoned in the 140-square-mile strip, under blockade since 2007, after Hamas assumed political control of the area. The blockade extends to a 1000-foot “buffer zone” on the Gaza side of a fence from which Israel bars activity.

Many observers are noting the caged condition of the Palestinians.

As *Tadamon* goes to print mass solidarity actions with the just struggle of the people of Palestine is continuing around the world reexpressing full support to their just struggle for defeat of occupation, the establishment of their own independent state with Jerusalem as its capital.

Tadamon joins the international solidarity movement calls for the immediate withdrawal of Israeli troops, the condemnation of the Israeli crimes committed against the Palestinian people.

These prisons, located in Zalingei and Shala, lack the most basic public health provisions to accommodate detainees, which could pose a serious threat to the health of comrades.
